Divine Love

## Key #2 Divine Love

**Romans 5:5:** Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

**1 Cor. 13:4-8 (AMP):** Love endures long *and* is patient and kind; love never is envious *nor* boils over with jealousy, is not boastful *or* vainglorious, does not display itself haughtily. <sup>5</sup> It is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride); it is not rude (unmannerly) *and* does not act unbecomingly. Love (God's love in us) does not insist on its own rights *or* its own way, *for* it is not self-seeking; it is not touchy *or* fretful *or* resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it [it pays no attention to a suffered wrong]. <sup>6</sup> It does not rejoice at injustice *and* unrighteousness, but rejoices when right *and* truth prevail. <sup>7</sup> Love bears up under anything *and* everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything [without weakening]. <sup>8</sup> Love never fails [never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end].
